**The goal** of the conference is to examine the EU and its mediarelation(s) from different national viewpoints and patterns. Overall, the main presentations will be based on research of the 2009 European Parliamentary elections and the media coverage thereof.

**The setup** of the conference will prove to be engaging, dynamic and interactive. This is achieved through the combination of presentations concerning the theoretical background, presentations of empirical and relevant research covering the media relations of the EU and its member states, drawing in specific on the recent EP elections. And, through the subsequent discussions concerning the results and conclusions in the discussion- panels, the conference subjects are given practical and applicable character. Furthermore, the presenters and contributors to the conference consist of professionals from the fields of academics, journalism, and political as well students of the MA European Union Studies (University Leiden).

**On October 8**, the first conference day, the main focus will be on the Netherlands and its media-relation with Europe. The conference will be officially opened by the Dutch Minister for European Affairs, Mr. Frans Timmermans. Several speakers will then first introduce the subject matter of the conference and different aspects thereof. In the afternoon, a forum of specialists in the fields of politics and media will give their view on the subject, followed by a discussion.

**On October 9 and 10** the subject matter of the conference is placed in an international and comparative perspective. On Friday October 9, research from various EU member states is presented which will serve as specific case-studies for EU-Media relations. On the third day, Saturday October 10, different aspects and individual components of EU-Media relations are examined and debated in the form of panel-discussions.
